



### **B.Sc. (Final Year) Practical Examination: Guidelines for Students**

**(Applicable to B.Sc. Final Year Students who are eligible to appear in TEE June 2020)**

1. For the lab courses of B.Sc. programme, written examination will be conducted in place of existing assessment method. The examination will be conducted at D.R. College, Golaghat (0416D) & Chaiduar College, Gohpur (0421D)
2. The practical examination of following courses of B.Sc. programme will be conducted as per schedule given below:

3. There will be separate question papers for each course. The time given to answer a 4 Credits course is 1 hour and for a 2 Credits course is 30 minutes. A gap of 15 minutes will be kept between any two consecutive examinations.
4. Question paper of a 4-credit course will have 25 objective type or short answer questions. Students will have to answer any 20 questions. Each question will be of 2½ marks. Similarly, question paper for 2-credit course will have 15 questions and students will have to answer any 10 questions. The maximum marks for 4-credit and 2-credit courses are assigned 50 and 25, respectively.
