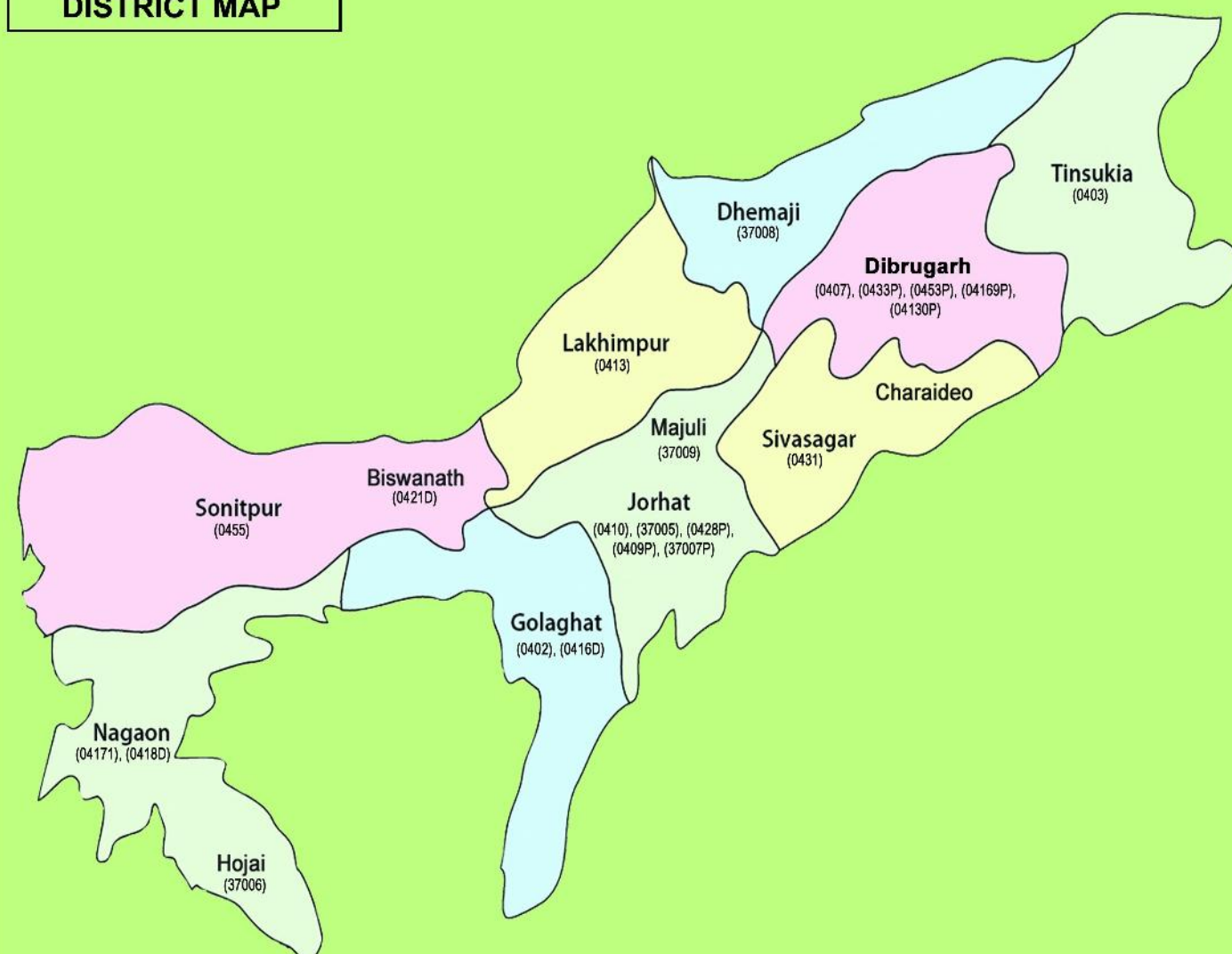

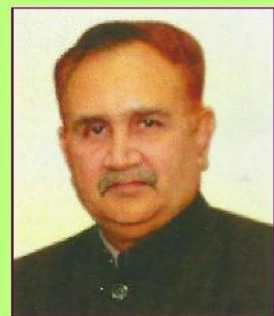

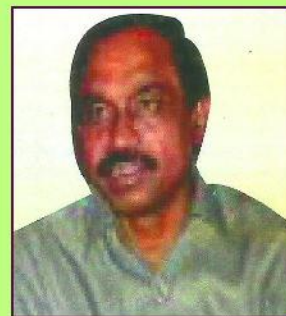

ABOUT REGIONAL CENTRE JORHAT

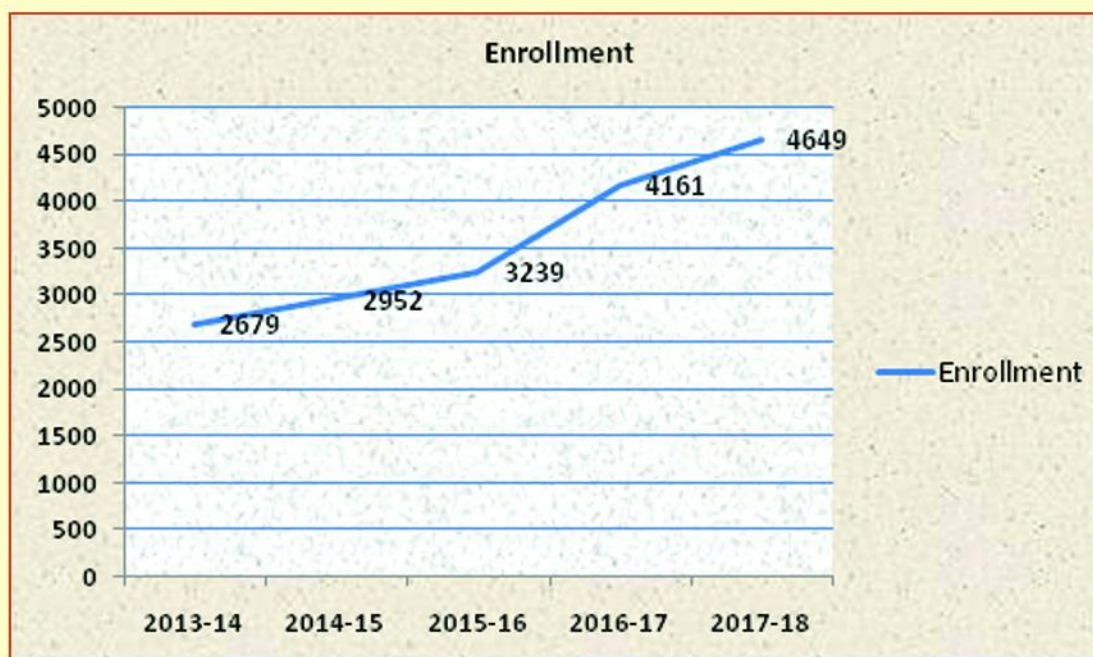
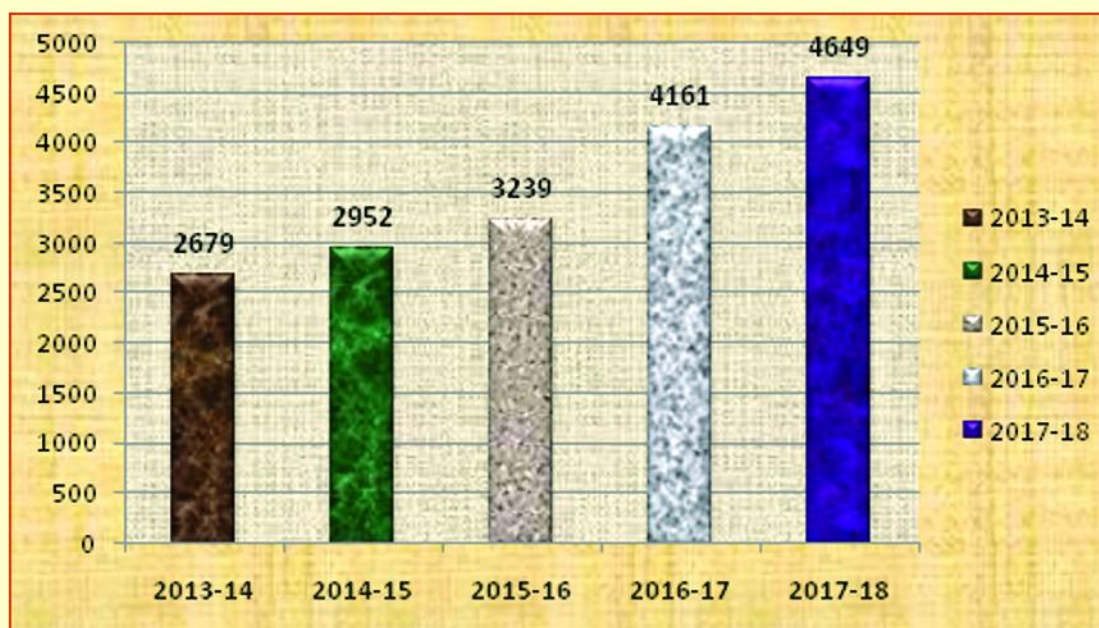
The Regional Centre Jorhat was activated at Jorhat in March, 2013 bifurcating Regional Centre Guwahati and had a very modest beginning with 18 study centres and a handful of staff from C.K.B. Commerce College premise.



In a very little span of time, the Regional Centre received mass acknowledgement from the people of all the districts and is growing gradually in terms of enrollment. It is presently serving the educational needs of about 20,000 learners by offering various Bachelors, Masters, Diplomas, PG Diplomas, Certificates and Bachelor Preparatory Programmes through 26 Learner's Support Centres. At the time of inception, Regional Centre Jorhat covered 9 districts under its jurisdiction (Jorhat, Golaghat, Sivasagar, Nagaon, Sonitpur, Dibrugarh, Tinsukia, Lakhimpur and Dhemaji) and now the numbers of districts has increased to 13 covering four new districts (Charaideo, Hojai, Biswanath, and Majuli). The RC is presently working from a rented building near Nehru Park, Jorhat. It is a great pleasure to share that IGNOU has conferred the Best Services Award to Regional Centre Jorhat for the year 2016-2017 in the 30th Convocation held on 13th April, 2017.

Conduct of Induction Meet

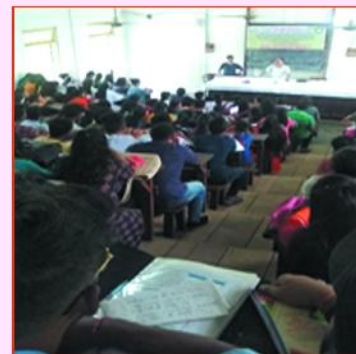

RC's ACHIEVEMENTS, PROMOTIONAL MEASURES AND INITIATIVES-

To sustain its growth and to take IGNOU to the unreached the Regional Centre has undertaken various innovative strategies and initiatives. During the last four years from inception Regional Centre Jorhat has undertaken various promotional activities about Open and Distance Learning (ODL) in different regions in Upper Assam areas and various interactive sessions with various educational institutions and colleges in the area.

Interaction with various educational institutions, clubs, NGOs etc have been undertaken over the years to make people aware of IGNOU and various programmes offered by IGNOU. Moreover, we also tried to reach out to the Tribal, Adivasi and Madrassa students in collaboration with different clubs and NGOs in remote places to make IGNOU visible in such backward areas and to encourage them to come forward to take such opportunity of higher education.

RC Jorhat has used the means of radio to reach to the unreached. Discussions on various topics related to Open and Distance Learning (ODL) and admission procedure in IGNOU, flexibility and examination system of IGNOU, student support services and counselling for IGNOU learners etc were also transmitted by Air India Radio Jorhat in the FM channel 103.4 MHz and also by Dibrugarh Radio Station. We have given publicity of the radio counselling via Facebook, News Paper besides regular publicity by AIR.

RC-Jorhat has reached out to common people by participating in Book fairs & Exhibitions. Informations are provided to the visitors there and prospectus was also sold by establishing stall in the Book Fair. We are pleased that RC has got a good response from such kind of activity.

RC Jorhat has undertaken promotional activity through massive mobile van campaigning in all the districts under its jurisdiction where the microphone was used to talk about IGNOU programmes on offer in Assamese. Leaflets both in Assamese and English were distributed to the people in various places during such campaigning.

We have also put up banners and posters in the National Highways as well as on the Assam State Transport Corporation (ASTC) Buses and at various prominent places in front of Colleges and other Educational Institutions.

Under the scheme of Fee Waiver in BPP for weaver community –Village Adoption under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan RC Jorhat have visited three places of weaver communities namely Disangmukh (Sibsagar), Kachua (Nagaon) and Gogamukh (Dhemaji). The staff members interacted with the prospective learners for free enrollment in BPP and also on other programmes of IGNOU in offer. Jorhat Regional Centre has taken such initiatives to reach out to the marginalized sections of our society and to serve the society at its best.

A team of RC Jorhat visited **Merapani (Golaghat), Disangmukh (Sibsagar) & Gelabil (Dergaon)** on **8/8/2018, 10/8/2018 & 13/8/2018** for promotional campaigning for the Admission for July, 2018 session. The area is inhabited mostly by Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribe peoples. House to house visit and interaction with the villagers was made by the team. They elaborated about the educational system of IGNOU, programmes of IGNOU on offer etc to the people. The team also elaborated the various benefits provided by the University to weavers and SC/ST candidates in pursuing higher education through IGNOU. From such promotional drive, we got an overwhelming response from the peoples of these areas. On the spot total 67 nos. of SC/ST candidates have taken admission from these places. Students are also approaching in personal at the Regional Centre from these places for admission.
